DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sept / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan
**** See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to all Legally Available Game Species

❖ **EXCEPTION:** No hunting of Sage Grouse

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

AREA A:

- No reservations required.
- Each hunter must sign in every day, before hunting.
- Access may be denied when moving or shipping cattle.
- Park in designated location or where instructed only.
- No motorized travel allowed off designated routes for any reason.

AREA B:

- No reservation required.
- Each hunter must sign in every day, before hunting.
- Park along county road or at designated location outside gate on eastern end of BMA.
- Do not block roads or gates.

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- **All roads not show as open on this map or marked on the ground as open are by default CLOSED to motorized travel.**
- No motorized travel allowed off county roads and designated travel route.
- Walk in hunting only
- Game retrieval is hunters responsibility
- No camping on BMA
- No open flames or smoking outside of vehicles.
- NO ATVs/OHVs ALLOWED ON BMA.

Hunters, police yourselves & report any apparent violations. Be aware that private landowners & staff have the authority to drive anywhere within the BMA, but will always attempt to stay away from areas being hunted, unless need / situation demands otherwise.

Please report any apparent misconduct of any individual(s) herding/pushing or harassing wildlife into specific areas or away from areas of free public hunting.


STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.


