DATES BMA IS OPEN: 1 Sep - through 1 Jan ****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

ATTENTION: Bears may be present on the Ranch, to include grizzlies. Exercise appropriate caution & the carry of Bear Spray is encouraged.

Open Friday – Monday Closed Tuesday - Thursday

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- No reservations or written permission required.
- All hunters must sign in before hunting.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- **Obey Safety Zones**
- Park In Designated Parking Areas Only ♦ Do Not Block Gates ♦ Walk-In Hunting Only
- No Littering ♦ No Latrine Pits
- No Motorized Game Retrieval Allowed, Use A Game Cart or Drag Out.
- No Flames Or Ignition Sources Allowed Outside Of Vehicles.
- All Vehicles Restricted To Public Roads.
- **NO ATVs/OHV's ALLOWED ON BMA.**

Hunters: Police Yourselfes & Report Any Apparent Misconduct or Violations.

Be aware that private Landowners & staff have the authority to drive anywhere within the BMA but will always attempt to stay away from areas being hunted, unless need/situation demands otherwise. They may also be present to inspect their Wells.


STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperater or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
