DEER/ELK HD 404 & ANTELOPE HD 404 (REVISED 2015)

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan

**\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species

**ATTENTION:** *In an effort to protect grizzly bears and promote public safety, hunters are advised that this BMA includes grizzly bear habitat. You are encouraged to carry / use bear spray in case of an encounter. Additional information on proper behavior when hunting in bear country is available from FWP.*

**WARNING:** *Hunters be aware because of coyote trapping occurring on property no dogs are allowed on BMA.*

### **WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

Written permission & reservations required to hunt. For reservations call 791-8235, 9am – 9pm daily after **22 August**. Reservations may not be made more than 14 days in advance of the period you wish to hunt and not less than 2 business days before. Written permission issued by FWP at Great Falls HQ's. (4600 Giant Springs Rd) Monday – Friday (excluding holidays) 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. HUNTERS MUST ALLOW AT LEAST 2 BUSINESS DAYS, EXCLUDING HOLIDAYS, BEFORE THE PERIOD YOU WISH TO HUNT TO OBTAIN YOUR PERMISSION SLIP. If planning on hunting any of the first three days of the general rifle season, the first day of your reservation must be on the opening day of the general rifle season or afterwards. You may not have a reservation which begins before and then has a 2<sup>nd</sup> and/or 3<sup>rd</sup> day that lapses over into the beginning of the general rifle season.

### **BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:**


- Limit of 2 parties of 1 – 4 hunters per party per day.
- **Bird hunting only allowed Mon – Thurs**
- Hunters may reserve no more than 3-days at a time & must complete hunt before making additional reservations.
- Park in designated parking area only at west side property, or within 30-feet of ranch road leading to HQ's on home place
- Walk-in hunting
- **No ATVs/OHVs allowed on BMA**
- No motorized travel allowed beyond 2<sup>nd</sup> pipe gate on home place road.
- No camping, No littering, No latrine pits left visible
- No open flames or ignition sources allowed outside of vehicles.
- All vehicles restricted to public roads and authorized designated trails, Do Not Block Gates

#### **STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- In accordance with BMP ARM rule 12.4.205 (k) - On BMA's that restrict hunter numbers or require reservations, a hunter may not reserve permission on more than one BMA for the same day(s). For aggregate (multi cooperators) BMA's, a hunter, or a party may still only make reservations with one (1) cooperator within that BMA per day.
- Individual or party hunters may not reserve permission to hunt for more than three days, per phone call, per BMA and may not call more than once per day. Individuals from the same hunting party may not each make reservations for consecutive "three-day blocks" in an attempt to book more than three days for that party.
- Hunter(s) who fail to call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a reservation may be banned from that BMA, or, for aggregate BMA's, from the property owned by the cooperator with whom they made the reservations.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
