DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan
****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- All hunters must sign in daily, before hunting.
- Each hunter must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- **Obey safety zones & travel restrictions**
- Parking restricted to along county roads and designated parking areas as posted on the ground ♦ **Do not block gates.**
- No motorized vehicles allowed off of designated roads, trails & parking areas.
- Walk-In Hunting Only From These Areas.
- On Private Land:
 - No camping ♦ No horses ♦ No littering ♦ No latrine pits left visible.
- No open flames or ignition sources allowed outside of vehicles.
- Hunters, no walking on / across crop land that has not been harvested
- **NO ATVs / OHVs ALLOWED ON BMA.**

*NOTE: The Most North Eastern Area Of This BMA May Be Closed In Oct When Cattle Are Staged In It For Shipping. Area Will Be Reopened Once Cattle Ship. Closed Pastures Will Be Signed.

HUNTERS: POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS.


Be aware that private Landowners & staff have the authority to drive anywhere within the BMA but will always attempt to stay away from areas being hunted, unless need/situation demands otherwise.

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
