DATES BMA IS OPEN: 1 Sep - through 1 Jan ****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

ATTENTION: Bears may be present on the Ranch, to include grizzlies. Exercise appropriate caution & the carry of Bear Spray is encouraged.

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- All hunters must sign in each day at one box, before hunting.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- **No trespassing within safety zones.**
- Park along county roads where safe to do so or in designated areas, do not block gates.
- Walk in hunting only from these areas.
- To prevent the spread of noxious weeds, you must clean your vehicle of as much mud & debris as possible before entering the BMA.
- No camping, littering, or latrine pits.
- No open flames or ignition sources allowed outside of vehicles.
- All vehicles restricted to public roads and authorized/designated trails shown on this map. Any road or trail within the boundary of the BMA, not shown on this map as open, is closed to motorized travel
- **No ATVs / OHVs allowed on BMA.**

HUNTERS: POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS.


STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
