DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan only. ****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

All Hunters must sign in each day before hunting. Hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access

BMA RULES, RESTRICTIONS: OBEY SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.

- Park Along County Road Or In Designated Area, Do Not Block Gates.
- No Camping, No Littering & No Latrine Pits Left Visible.
- No Open Flames Or Ignition Sources Allowed Outside Of Vehicles.
- NO Motorized Vehicles Allowed On BMA
- All Vehicles Restricted To Public Roads.
- Walk In Hunting Only by foot or horses.


HUNTERS, POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS.

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
