

**CATLIN RANCH BMA # 177**  
**DEER/ELK HD 451 / 452 / 580 & ANTELOPE HD 490 / 491 (2016)**

BMA is open to public elk hunting only during the time period of 1 Sep – 1 Jan, within the constraints of season dates and conditions outlined on page 116 of the 2016 Hunting Regulations.

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** 1 Sep through 1 Jan only. **\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**ATTENTION:** *Bears may be present on the Ranch, to include grizzlies. Exercise appropriate caution & the carry of Bear Spray is encouraged.*

**HUNTABLE GAME:** NO MULE DEER HUNTING. Otherwise, Open to All Other Legally Available Game Species

**WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

- All hunters must sign in daily before hunting.
- All hunters must fill in all information on coupon.
- Place coupon stub on dash face up.
- Park in a manner so that you do not cause a hazard to other traffic.
- **DO NOT BLOCK ANY GATES. DO NOT PARK WITHIN 100 FEET TO EITHER SIDE OF ANY GATE.**

**BMA RULES, RESTRICTIONS:**

- Stay out of safety zones. No hunting or trespassing within them.
- Walk in hunting only.
- No motorized travel allowed within BMA.
- No camping, no littering
- No latrine pits on private lands left visible.
- No open flames or ignition sources allowed outside of vehicles.
- No Horses allowed on BMA
- **No ATV's / OHV's allowed on BMA.**

**HUNTERS, POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS.**


**BE AWARE THAT PRIVATE LANDOWNERS & STAFF HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO DRIVE ANYWHERE WITHIN BMA BUT WILL ALWAYS ATTEMPT TO STAY AWAY FROM AREAS BEING HUNTED UNLESS NEED/SITUATION DEMANDS OTHERWISE.**

**STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause, and this will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP, which will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.


