**DEER/ELK HD419 & 429 & ANTELOPE HD 471 (2016)**

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan only. **\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species.

**WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

- All hunters must sign in daily before hunting.
- Hunters must fill out all information on coupon & place coupon stub on dash face up.

**BMA RULES, RESTRICTIONS: OBEY SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.**

- Park Along County Road And Do Not Block Gates.
- No Motorized Vehicles Allowed on BMA.
- Walk In Hunting Only.
- No Camping, No Littering.
- No Latrine Pits.
- No Open Flames Or Ignition Sources Allowed Outside Of Vehicles.


HUNTERS, POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS. BE AWARE THAT PRIVATE LANDOWNERS & STAFF HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO DRIVE ANYWHERE WITHIN BMA BUT WILL ALWAYS ATTEMPT TO STAY AWAY FROM AREAS BEING HUNTED UNLESS NEED/SITUATION DEMANDS OTHERWISE.

**STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperater or their designated representative may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause, and this will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP, which will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
