DEER/ELK HD 410 & ANTELOPE HD 481 (2016)

DATES BMA IS OPEN: Beginning the General Deer / Elk Rifle Season in Oct, through Upland Bird season ending 1 Jan only. ****See applicable hunting regulations for specific opening date of General Deer/Elk rifle season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species except for Sage Grouse.

HUNTERS DO NOT DISTURB RANCH STAFF OR OWNER FOR INFORMATION CONCERNING HUNTING THIS BMA. ALL INFORMATION IS CONTAINED ON THIS MAP AND YOU MAY CONTACT AREA FWP PATROLLER FOR MORE DETAILS.

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- Reservations required to hunt the “Home Place” only as identified on front of this map.
- Once you have a reservation, each hunter must sign in daily before hunting.
- For reservations, call 791- 8232 between 9 am – 9 pm 7-days a week.
- Reservation will be taken starting **10 Oct** and will not be taken more than 14 days in advance of the period you wish to hunt. There is not a per day hunter limit so you will not have exclusive use of this area.
- **To hunt all other areas aside from the Home Place:**
 - No reservations are required. Each hunter must sign in once per day at any sign in box prior to hunting.

BMA RULES, RESTRICTIONS: OBEY SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.

- No motorized vehicle allowed on the BMA.
- Game retrieval is your responsibility and executed on foot.
- Vehicles are restricted to public roads and authorized designated trails.
- Park along these roads & trails and do not block any gates.
- Walk in hunting only from these roads & trails.
- No camping, no littering & no latrine pits on private lands left visible.
- No open flames or ignition sources allowed outside of vehicles.


HUNTERS, POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS. BE AWARE THAT PRIVATE LANDOWNERS & STAFF HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO DRIVE ANYWHERE WITHIN BMA BUT WILL ALWAYS ATTEMPT TO STAY AWAY FROM AREAS BEING HUNTED UNLESS NEED/SITUATION DEMANDS OTHERWISE.

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperators or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause, and this will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP, which will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
