DATES BMA IS OPEN: 1 Sep - through 1 Jan only. ****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS: Written permission & reservations required to hunt. For reservation call 406-491-3049 between 6 pm – 9 pm at least 2 days in advance, but not more than 14 days in advance of the period you wish to hunt. **Reservation may not be made earlier than 22 Aug.** All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access. Permission slips issued first morning of hunt between 6 am – 8 am only. BMA accepts 3 parties of 1 – 4 hunters per party per day. One party for area A & 2 parties for area B. Access to adjacent public lands also provide upon request & does not count towards parties per day limit.

BMA RULES, RESTRICTIONS: OBEY SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.

- Park in designated location only.
- Do Not Block Gates.
- No Camping, No Littering, No Latrine Pits On Private Lands Left Visible.
- Horses allowed but must be fed certified weed seed free hay at least 48 hours prior to arriving on and all during time horses are on property.
- No Open Flames Or Ignition Sources Allowed Outside Of Vehicles.
- All Vehicles Restricted To Public Roads and Authorized, Designated Trails & Parking Areas. .
- Walk In Hunting Only.
- **NO ATVs/OHVs ALLOWED ON BMA.**

HUNTERS, POLICE YOURSELVES & REPORT ANY APPARENT MISCONDUCT OR VIOLATIONS.


HUNTERS BE AWARE THAT PRIVATE LANDOWNERS & STAFF HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO DRIVE ANYWHERE WITHIN BMA BUT WILL ALWAYS ATTEMPT TO STAY AWAY FROM AREAS BEING HUNTED UNLESS NEED/SITUATION DEMANDS OTHERWISE.

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- In accordance with BMP ARM rule 12.4.205 (k) - On BMA's that restrict hunter numbers or require reservations, a hunter may not reserve permission on more than one BMA for the same day(s). For aggregate (multi cooperators) BMA's, a hunter, or a party may still only make reservations with one (1) cooperator within that BMA per day.
- Individual or party hunters may not reserve permission to hunt for more than three days, per phone call, per BMA and may not call more than once per day. Individuals from the same hunting party may not each make reservations for consecutive "three-day blocks" in an attempt to book more than three days for that party.
- Hunter(s) who fail to call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a reservation may be banned from that BMA.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause, and this will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP, which will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.


