**DEER/ELK HD 400 & ANTELOPE HD 404 (REVISED 2016)**

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** 1 Sep – 1 Jan **\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species

**LANDOWNER REQUESTS MORE DEER HUNTERS - especially doe hunters**

## **WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

### **▪ TO GET TO HOME PLACE / HQ'S**

- Take exit #339 from HWY 15.
- Go West through Conrad on Main St.
- Take a left at Central Ave (just before the Cenex station).
- Follow the road (East) out of town, bearing left at fork.
- Once you cross over the over-pass, the HQs is 6.2 miles east on Sollid Rd, on the left (North) side.

## **Home Place – AREA A**

- **This portion of BMA is open Thurs – Mon, closed Tues & Weds.**
- **Reservations required for the first 3 weeks of pheasant season only.**
  - To hunt during this period, call **791-8226, between 9am –9pm only.**
  - Prior to or after this period, no reservations are required.
  - Reservations may be made no more than 14 days in advance of the first day you wish to hunt.
  - You must complete your reserved hunt before making additional reservations.
  - During this period, hunter numbers are limited to 4 hunters per day and you may only have one day per reservation.
- All Hunters must sign in at sign-in box before hunting.
  - You must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

## **ALL OTHER PARCELLS–**

- No reservations required ♦ No limit on hunters per day ♦ Park on county roads.
- All hunters must sign in at sign in box.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

**HUNTERS: BE AWARE THAT DEVRIES FAMILY MEMBERS MAY ALSO BE PRESENT & HUNTING AT THE SAME TIME AS YOU.**

## **BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:**

- **Obey all safety zones and landowners instructions.**
- Walk in hunting only.
- Park in designated areas only.
- No motorized vehicles allowed on BMA.


### **STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
