

# **TETON RIVER #22**

**DEER & ANTELOPE HD 404 (REVISED 2016)**

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan  
**\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\*.**

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species

**ATTENTION:** *Be advised that this BMA includes grizzly bear habitat. You are encouraged to carry/use bear spray in case of an encounter. Additional information on proper behavior when hunting in bear country is available from FWP.*

## **WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

- **Do not enter BMA before 6:30 am, or one-half hour before legal shooting light, whichever is later, according to the current FWP Regulations Sunrise/Sunset Table.**
- Written permission required to hunt, & issued after 6:30 am or one day prior to hunt.
- No reservations taken. Access is on a first come first served basis.
- **No Bird hunting allowed the opening day of the Deer General Rifle Season.**

Access to the center & western side of Area may be shut off due to road conditions based on weather. Landowner will make determination & has final say.

## **BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:**

- **NO HUNTING OR TRESPASSING IN SAFETY ZONE OR AROUND BUILDINGS & LIVESTOCK.**
- **DNRC Lands:** No rifle hunting permitted anywhere on these lands if livestock or building are located within ¼ mile, even if said entities are located on adjacent private lands.
- Walk-in hunting only - no road hunting allowed.
- Drive from HQ's to parking area only, park where instructed.
- No hunting allowed while retrieving game.
- No ATVs / OHVs allowed on the BMA.


### **STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- In accordance with BMP ARM rule 12.4.205 (k) - On BMA's that restrict hunter numbers or require reservations, a hunter may not reserve permission on more than one BMA for the same day(s). For aggregate (multi cooperators) BMA's, a hunter, or a party may make reservations with up to three (3) cooperators within that BMA.
- Individual or party hunters may not reserve permission to hunt for more than three days, per phone call, per BMA and may not call more than once per day. Individuals from the same hunting party may not each make reservations for consecutive "three-day blocks" in an attempt to book more than three days for that party.
- Hunter(s) who fail to call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a reservation may be banned from that BMA, or, for aggregate BMA's, from the property owned by the cooperator with whom they made the reservations.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
