DEER/ELK HD 406 & ANTELOPE HD 404 (REVISED 2016)

DATES BMA IS OPEN: 1 Sep - through 1 Jan ** See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season**

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

ATTENTION: Bears may be present on the Ranch, to include grizzlies. Exercise appropriate caution & the carry of Bear Spray is encouraged.

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- All hunters must sign in daily, before hunting.
- Hunters only need to sign in at one of the sign-in boxes located throughout the BMA.
- Any & all boxes are valid for entire BMA, except for Area A, which requires separate reservations & written permission.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

EXCEPTION, AREA A

- Reservations & written permission required.
- Call 791-8231, 9:00 am – 9:00 pm daily, *after 22 August*.
 - For reservations outside this time period call (406) 278-5332 evenings & weekends at a reasonable hour.
- Limit of 20 Hunters per day.
- All hunters must sign in at ONE of the parking areas indicated on the map, before hunting.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

SIGNING IN AT BOXES DOES NOT GRANT ACCESS TO AREA A. PERMISSION FROM AREA A DOES NOT GRANT ACCESS TO REST OF BMA, HUNTERS MUST STILL SIGN IN AT ONE BOX ANYWHERE ON BMA BEFORE HUNTING.


BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- **OBEY ALL SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.**
- Walk in hunting only.
- Parking signs indicate you can park along county road if able to safely do so.
- No ATVs or other forms of motorized vehicles allowed on BMA.
- All vehicles restricted to public roads and authorized/designated trails if posted as open or shown on this map as open.
- No stopping or pulling off trails except to allow other vehicles to pass.

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
