DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons **after 1 Sept** / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species.

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS: No permission or reservations required.

NO CAMPING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHIN THIS BMA

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- Walk-in via foot or horseback from designated parking areas only.
 - Certified weed seed free hay is required if bringing livestock onto the BMA.
- No motorized vehicles allowed on private property.
- All motorized vehicles restricted to County Road or Authorized / Designated Travel Routes only.
- All roads within this BMA that are not shown on as open on this map or posted as open on the ground, are closed to all motorized use.

CAMPING ON PUBLIC LANDS (BLM & DNRC):

- Allowed in accordance with BLM rules: 16 day stay limit. At the end of the 16 day period, individuals **must** relocate 1/2 mile away from the currently occupied campsite.
- Individuals may not occupy the same camping site more than 16 days during a 30 day period.
- Camp must be within 100 yards of open roads.
- Direct access by motor vehicle is permitted to and from campsites using the most direct route to avoid damage to soils and vegetation.


STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
