

GOLDEN SPUR BMA # 3

Deer HD 400 & Antelope HD 404 (revised 2016)

DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan

****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS: Reservations are only required for Upland Bird hunting & only if hunting during the first 3 weeks (21 days) of pheasant season. Prior to the beginning of pheasant season and after the third Saturday during pheasant season through to 1 Jan, no reservations are required. All hunters must sign in daily before hunting.

AREA A: All private lands east of railroad tracks closed to public hunting the first 4-days of the deer general rifle season.

3-WEEK PERIOD AT BEGINNING OF PHEASANT SEASON:

- Reservations accepted beginning no more than 21 days in advance of the day you wish to hunt within this three-week period. Reservations made by calling the answering service @ **791-8228**, between 9am –9pm only, at least 24 hrs in advance. Cancellation must be made at least 2 days in advance.
- BMA allows 12 hunters per day (this includes big game as well as bird hunters). No Upland Bird hunting allowed Tues & Weds.
- All reservation for more than one day must be for consecutive days if open slots allow. Hunters may not reserve more than 2 consecutive days at a time and must complete their reserved hunt before making additional reservations.
- **Party Hunters:** Only 1 person per party may make reservations for the whole party. Any person named as a party member on a reservation, must wait until after the reserved hunt period to make additional reservations, even if you were not in attendance for the hunt. The only exception is if you call to remove your name from the reservation which must be done at least 2 days prior to the reservation. Individual members of a party may not each make reservations for additional days in an attempt to gain access for more than 2 consecutive days.
- The daily limit of 12 hunters per day will also restrict or determine how many members of a party will be able to get access.

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:


- All motorized vehicles restricted to public roads.
- **Any road not shown on this map as OPEN / PUBLIC, is by default closed to motorized use.**
- Walk in hunting only.
- Park along public roads, or in authorized parking areas.
- Observe safety zones around buildings and livestock & equipment.
- No ATVs/OHVs or other forms of motorized vehicles allowed on BMA

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
