DEER/ELK HD 412 & ANTELOPE HD 480 (Revised 2016)

BMA is open to public elk hunting only during the time period of 1 Sep – 1 Jan, within the constraints of season dates and conditions outlined on page 116 of the 2016 Hunting Regulations.

DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sept / Upland Bird Seasons – through 1 Jan

**** See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to all Legally Available Game Species

LANDOWNER IS ASKING FOR MORE DOE HUNTERS - HAS LOTS OF WHITETAILS

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- Reservations required. Call (406) 538-5584 at least 24 hrs in advance.
- *No Reservations taken prior to 22 August.*
- Hunter numbers per day limited by parcel.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- Obey all safety zones and landowners instructions.
- No hunting around livestock or structures.
- Walk-in hunting only.
- Park in designated areas only.
- No motorized vehicles allowed on BMA.

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:


- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- In accordance with BMP ARM rule 12.4.205 (k) - On BMAs that restrict hunter numbers or require reservations, a hunter may not reserve permission on more than one BMA for the same day(s). Individual or party hunters may not reserve permission to hunt for more than three days, per phone call, per BMA and may not call more than once per day. Individuals from the same hunting party may not each make reservations for consecutive three day blocks in an attempt to book more than three days for that party.
- Hunter(s) who fail to call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a reservation may be banned from that BMA, or, for aggregate BMAs, from the property owned by the cooperator with whom they made the reservations.
- A cooperator may deny access to an individual for cause IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
