DEER/ELK HD 426/447/471 & ANTELOPE HD 470/471/473 (REVISED 2016)

DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sep / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan

****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS: PERMISSION FROM ONE LANDOWNER DOES NOT APPLY TO THE OTHER

DO NOT DISTURB OR ATTEMPT TO ACCESS EITHER AREA 1 or 2 PRIOR TO 6 am.

AREA 1 - Meissner Circle Ranch: 2nd house in on Meissner Lane

- OPEN Thurs – Sun, CLOSED Mon – Wed.
- Hunters must make reservations by calling 737-4420, between 7pm – 9pm, at least 1 day in advance.
- Cooperator will begin taking reservations **29 August**.
- Allows 2 deer hunters per 4-day period.
- All hunters must check in at 2nd house, **no earlier than 6 am**, to receive written permission.
- Hunters must check out each night before dark, unless they have game down. In this case, contact Ranch HQ's personnel & let them know your situation.
- **Goat hunters, See Area 2A info below.**

AREA 2 & 2A – Tureck:

- For Reservations, call 567-2480 or contact in person between 8am – 8pm after 22 August. Allows 6 – 7 people per day or 2 – 3 parties per day.
- Permission issued between 7 am – 9 pm
- Hunters need to go to the Cooperator's HQ's to receive written permission.
- **No Sage Grouse Hunting Allowed.**
- **Area 2 - the Arrow Creek area** - Cooperator will direct hunters to designated parking areas.
- **Area 2A Square Butte** - Hunters must receive trespass authorization from Area 1 (Meissner HQ's) and then park at the designated parking area for all Meissner hunters. If hunters desire to hunt Area 1, then reservations are required as directed above.
- If you wish to hunt only area 2A or Square Butte, but not Area 1, you will need a reservation for Area 2A and then trespass authorization from Area 1. Additionally, You Must Stop & Check IN and OUT With Area 1. If you wish to only hunt Area 1, reservations with area 2/2A are not required.


BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS: Obey all safety zones and landowners instructions.

- Walk-in hunting only. Park in designated areas or where instructed.
- All motorized vehicles restricted to county roads or established authorized private roads.
- **No road hunting allowed** while on private roads.
- All roads not marked as open on this map are closed to motorized travel.
- **NO ATVs/OHVs ALLOWED ON BMA.**

STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands. All hunters must have a state lands recreational permit to hunt state lands including those within BMA's.
- In accordance with BMP ARM rule 12.4.205 (k) - On BMA's that restrict hunter numbers or require reservations, a hunter may not reserve permission on more than one BMA for the same day(s). Individual or party hunters may not reserve permission to hunt for more than three days, per phone call, per BMA and may not call more than once per day. Individuals from the same hunting party may not each make reservations for consecutive "three day blocks" in an attempt to book more than three days for that party.
- Hunter(s) who fail to call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a reservation may be banned from that BMA, or, for aggregate BMA's, from the property owned by the cooperators with whom they made the reservations.
- A cooperators may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
