**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** 1 Sep - through 1 Jan **\*\*See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\*** **UGB HUNTING OPPORTUNITY IS EXTREMELY POOR RANCH REQUESTS MORE ELK HUNTERS**

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species

**To combat the spread of noxious weeds, no muddy or excessively filthy vehicles will be allowed on property.**

**ATTENTION:** Bears may be present on the Ranch, to include grizzlies. Exercise appropriate caution & the carry of Bear Spray is encouraged.

**WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS**

**Hunters Only Using Ranch to Access USFS:**

All hunters only using this BMA to camp on or park on and then access the adjacent forest service land must sign in at either of the boxes located at the designated parking areas at Johnsons Crossing or the western gate. Upon completing your hunt, hunters must fill out the stub portion of the coupon where it asks the number of days you parked on the BMA for that trip. Return this stub to FWP via dropping it in the box onsite or mailing it to: *R4 HAEP, 4600 GIANT SPRINGS RD, GREAT FALLS MT 59405.*

**SIGNING-IN AT JOHNSON CROSSING DOES NOT ENTITLE YOU TO HUNT ON THE RANCH, IT IS USFS ACCESS ONLY**


**Hunters Wishing to Hunt On the Ranch:**

- Reservations & written permission required. Reservation made by call (406) 472-3380 beginning **25 Aug between 6am – 8am** only.
- Permission slips issued between 6:00am – 8:00am only on the morning of the hunt or 1 day prior. Hunters must pick up permission slips **by 8:00am** the first day of their hunt or lose their reservation.
- Hunter numbers limited to 2 parties of 1 – 3 hunters per party per day. Hunters may reserve up to 3 consecutive days. Hunters must completed their reserved hunt and leave the ranch before making additional reservations.
- During the General Rifle season, a harvest limit of 3 bucks per week.
- BMA will accept up to 5, 441-50 permit holders per year.
- All kills must be reported to manager via harvest survey cards provide with permission slips.
- Anyone who either does not intend to use all of their reserved days or fills harvest early is asked to please let manager know so unused days may be filled.
- Walk-in hunting via foot or horseback only. Certified weed seed free hay is required if bringing livestock onto the Ranch.
- All motorized vehicles restricted to county road and the designated private ranch road identified on this map as open.
- All other internal ranch roads, not identified on this map as open, are closed to motorized travel.
- Parking is allowed anywhere along these open, designated roads & trails. Hunters must pull off only as far as required to safely allow other vehicles & ranch equipment to pass. Do Not Block Gates.

**STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- In accordance with BMP ARM rule 12.4.205 (k) - On BMA's that restrict hunter numbers or require reservations, a hunter may not reserve permission on more than one BMA for the same day(s). For aggregate (multi cooperators) BMA's, a hunter, or a party may still only make reservations with one (1) cooperator within that BMA per day.
- Individual or party hunters may not reserve permission to hunt for more than three days, per phone call, per BMA and may not call more than once per day. Individuals from the same hunting party may not each make reservations for consecutive "three-day blocks" in an attempt to book more than three days for that party.
- Hunter(s) who fail to call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel a reservation may be banned from that BMA, or, for aggregate BMA's, from the property owned by the cooperator with whom they made the reservations.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual "for cause" IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
