**DEER/ELK HD 446 ANTELOPE HD 490 (REVISED 2011)**

**DATES BMA IS OPEN:** Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sept / Upland Bird Seasons - through 1 Jan  
**\*\* See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season\*\***

**Is not participating in elk shoulder season hunting.** Elk hunting **only** allowed during the standard 6-week archery season (Sep 3 – Oct 16) and the 5-week general rifle season (Oct 22 – Nov 27).

**HUNTABLE GAME:** Open to All Legally Available Game Species

## **WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:**

- Hunters must sign in daily at the sign-in box, before hunting.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.
- **Archery Season** - Hunting allowed on all four sections.
- **General Season** - The southern two sections (7 & 8) limited, bow hunting only allowed, due to cattle grazing area. The northern two sections (5 & 6) remain unrestricted.

## **BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:**

- **OBEY ALL SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.**
- Walk-in hunting only.
- Park in designated areas.
- All motorized vehicles restricted to county roads or established authorized secondary roads


## **STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:**

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
