DATES BMA IS OPEN: Archery & Rifle Seasons after 1 Sept / Upland Bird Seasons – through 1 Jan
****See applicable hunting regulations for specific dates for each Species & Season****

BMA is open to public elk hunting only during the time period of 1 Sep – 1 Jan, within the constraints of season dates and conditions outlined on page 116 of the 2016 Hunting Regulations.

HUNTABLE GAME: Open to All Legally Available Game Species.

NO SAGE GROUSE HUNTING ALLOWED ON THE PRIVATE LAND WITHIN THIS BMA.

WHERE & HOW TO GAIN ACCESS:

- All hunters must sign in daily at any one sign in box located throughout BMA.
- All hunters must fill out all information on any hunter record required for access.

BMA RULES & RESTRICTIONS:

- **OBEY ALL SAFETY ZONES AND LANDOWNERS INSTRUCTIONS.**
- All vehicles restricted to public roads and authorized/designated trails.
- Parking is along these areas
- Walk-in hunting from these areas.
- **On private property within this BMA:** No ATVs/OHVs allowed on this BMA.

CAMPING ON PUBLIC LANDS (BLM & DNRC):

- In accordance with latest BLM recreational use rules established in 2013:
 - Individuals may not occupy the same camping site more than 16 days during a 30 day period.
 - At the end of the 16 day period, individuals must relocate to new camp site that is not within a ½ mile radius of original camp site. (See BLM recreational use rules for details.)
 - Camp must be within 100 yards of open roads.
 - Direct access by motor vehicle is permitted to and from campsites using the most direct route to avoid damage to soils and vegetation.


STANDARD BLOCK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM RULES:

- BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible, (via public roads and watercourses, and other legal means of access) public (State or Federal) lands.
- A cooperator or their designated representative may deny access to an individual “for cause” IAW, ARM rule 12.4.205 (d). An example - intoxication, belligerence or violent behavior, violation of BMA rules, muddy/excessively filthy vehicle, etc. Cooperators may also ask FWP to ban an individual(s) for cause. This will be via a formal letter to the individual(s) from FWP and will specify the length of the ban, reasons, and complainant.
- Violations of any BMA rules and/or State hunting regulations will be prosecuted. Convictions may result in the loss of Block Management access privileges in addition to other penalties.
