

# Peabody Ranch Block Management Area #111 2016

**Hunters, Please be aware of weeds.** Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission is required. All hunters are required to have a written permission slip in hand before hunting. Hunter numbers will be limited to 1 party per day. Permission can be obtained by: 1) Calling MT FWP R5's Block Management desk at 247-2940 for a prerequisite permission slip (beginning August 22). 2) Hunters are then required to reserve individual hunting days in advance at the above number; 3) Once at the BMA, hunters are required to sign-in each day at the roster box (see map) before hunting. Permission slips must be displayed on the vehicle dash while hunting. If a hunter does not hunt all of their reserved days, please call R5's Block Management desk ASAP to give someone else an opportunity to hunt.

Primary hunting opportunities: Mule deer, whitetail deer and elk (HD 590), and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

**Vehicles must be parked at the roster box only.** No parking anywhere else.

**If you wish to hunt the state land adjacent to this BMA, the lessee has requested prior notification. Contact information will be provided on the permission slip.**

No camping or open fires allowed, no smoking outside vehicle, leave all gates as you find them. Please do not climb over gates or fences, use gates to cross pastures.

Access to portions of the ranch may be temporarily restricted due to ranch operations.


Special restrictions may apply in livestock areas. Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.

These regulations are in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.

BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible public lands shown within the BMA boundaries. Abide by managing agency's regulations.
