

# C H Ranch Block Management Area #124 2016

**Hunters, Please be aware of weeds.** Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

A written permission slip from the landowner is not required. Permission can be obtained by signing in at one of the roster boxes (see map). **Every hunter must fill out a coupon daily before hunting.** Hunter portion of the coupon must be visibly displayed on the vehicle dash. Please return hunter portion of the coupon when done hunting.

For convenience, a written permission slip may be obtained through the Grewell BMA #76 (see map/rules for BMA #76).

Primary hunting opportunities: Mule deer and whitetail deer (HD 502, 575), and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

**WALK-IN ONLY:** Farewell Creek Unit: vehicles may be parked along county road. Cottonwood Creek Unit: walk-in from parking area at the end of Taylor Road (through Taylor BMA # 78) or as directed by landowner if accessing through BMA #76. This includes ATVs and motorcycles. Vehicles may be used for game retrieval with landowner permission only.

Vehicles will be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.


Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.

No camping or open fires allowed, no smoking outside vehicle, leave all gates as you find them.

These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
