

# Warner Farm Block Management Area #158 2016

**Hunters, Please be aware of weeds.** Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission is required and hunter numbers will be limited to 9 per day or 3 parties per day. Permission can be obtained in advance by calling 473-2202 from 6a.m.– 9a.m. and 7a.m. – 9p.m. (beginning August 22). Callers earlier or later may be denied permission. Permission slips will be issued at ranch headquarters (see map).

Primary hunting opportunities: Mule deer, (HD 511), antelope (HD 501) and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

**Walk-in only from county roads.** Vehicles are not allowed on two-track roads or off road. Vehicles may be parked along county roads. No ATVs or motorcycles.

Vehicles will be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

No open fires allowed, no smoking outside vehicle, leave all gates as you find them.


**No hunting around livestock.** Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.

These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
