

Griffith Ranch-Hopley Block Management Area #170 2016

Hunters, Please be aware of weeds. Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission is required and hunter numbers will be limited to 8 per day or 3 parties. Phone reservations can be made in advance by calling 632-4606 (beginning August 22). Permission slips will be issued at 402 Division, Harlowton, by appointment. Telephone calls accepted/permission slips issued: 6 a.m. to 8 a.m.; noon to 1 p.m.; and 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. Long distance telephone calls will not be returned.

Hunting opportunities: Mule deer and elk (HD 540) and antelope (HD 500). BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

WALK-IN ONLY: Vehicles may be parked along county roads or at designated parking areas. ATVs and motorcycles are not allowed.

Vehicles will be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

Leave all gates as you find them.


Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.

These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.

Griffith Ranch Hopley Block Management Area #170


