

# Diamond Quarter Circle Ranch Block Management Area #21 2016

**Hunters, Please be aware of weeds.** Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Hunting by advance reservation only. Permission can be obtained by calling 358-2405 (beginning August 22). Hunter numbers will be limited to 5 per day or 2 parties per day. Hunters must check in at ranch and obtain written permission before hunting.

Primary hunting opportunities: Antelope (HD 530 and 701), whitetail and mule deer (HD 530, 701), turkey, upland birds and waterfowl. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

Vehicles permitted only on designated open roads. No off road vehicle use permitted, do not use ranch roads when wet. ATVs and motorcycles are not allowed.

Vehicles may be parked at the ranch or in designated parking areas. Vehicles shall be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

No open fires allowed. Leave all gates as you find them. Camping with landowner permission only.


Please use caution when livestock are present. Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.

These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
