

Currant Creek Block Management Area #22 2016

Hunters, Please be aware of weeds. Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Primary hunting opportunities: Antelope (HD 513), mule deer (HD 530), and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

Written permission is required and may be obtained in advance by contacting FWP (see below) beginning Aug. 22. Deer, upland bird, waterfowl, and archery antelope hunters are required to obtain a written permission slip each time before hunting and will be limited to one ranch unit. Rifle antelope hunters must obtain a season-long permission slip prior to their first visit. **On all visits**, rifle antelope hunters are required to sign in at one of four roster boxes (see map) each day before hunting. On opening day of rifle antelope season, hunter numbers will be limited and assigned to one ranch unit. For the remainder of the rifle season, antelope hunter numbers will not be limited and they may hunt the entire BMA. Hunters may only take the game animals listed on their permission slips. Only two non-hunting companions per licensee allowed on Mercer unit.

Vehicles will be allowed as follows:

- **Mercer Unit: Vehicles, except OHVs, allowed on designated open roads only (see map) outside of walk-in areas. OHVs not allowed off county roads. No off-road travel.**
- **Lehfeldt Unit: Vehicles allowed on established roads only outside of walk-in area. No off-road travel.**
- **Hansen Unit: No vehicular travel. Walk-in only from county roads/highway.**

Camping may be allowed at landowner's discretion. Contact FWP for landowner information. This applies to state school trust lands along Woman's Pocket Road as well.

This BMA includes state school trust lands on which BMA restrictions apply. Abide by posted signs. BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible federal lands within the BMA boundaries. Abide by managing agency's regulations.


These regulations shall be in effect September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
