

# Keebler Ranch Block Management Area #28 2016

**Hunters, Please be aware of weeds.** Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

This BMA is divided into two units: North and South of Cottonwood Creek (see map).

**Big Game Hunters:** On the South unit written permission is required for big game hunters and hunter numbers will be limited to 8 per day or 2 parties. Permission can be obtained in advance by calling 652-3386 (beginning August 22). Telephone calls accepted from 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.

On the North Unit daily sign in is required (see map). A written permission slip from the landowner is not required. Permission can be obtained by signing in at the roster box (see map). **Every hunter must fill out a coupon daily before hunting.** Hunter portion of the coupon must be visibly displayed on the vehicle dash. Please return hunter portion of the coupon when done hunting.

**Bird Hunters:** Daily Sign in is required on both north and south units.

Primary hunting opportunities: Mule deer (HD 502) and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

Vehicles allowed on county or designated ranch roads (see map). Walk-in access from roads. No ATVs or motorcycles except for game retrieval ONLY.

Vehicles will be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate. Please stay away from ranch buildings. Close all gates every time whether they were open or not.

Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.


These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.

BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible public lands shown within the BMA boundaries. Abide by managing agency's regulations. Driving is prohibited on State Lands. Walk-in only.
