

# Grand Duke Ranch Block Management Area #47 2016

**Hunters, Please be aware of weeds.** Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission is required and hunter numbers will be limited to 10-15 per day. Permission can be obtained by calling 632-4135 or 539-6529 (beginning August 22) to arrange a time to meet the landowner and receive a permission slip. Permission slips will be issued at ranch headquarters (see map).

Primary hunting opportunities: Antelope (HD 570) and mule deer (HD 570). BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

Vehicles permitted only on designated open roads (see map). Absolutely no motorized vehicles allowed off roads.

Parking will be allowed along designated roads. Vehicles will be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

No open fires allowed, camping with landowner permission only, leave all gates as you find them.

Hunting may be limited in areas where livestock are present.


Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.

These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
