

Bermes Ranch Block Management Area #59 2016

Hunters, Please be aware of weeds. Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission is required. Permission can be obtained in advance by calling Clint Schmidt at 669-3228 beginning on September 1. Telephone calls accepted/permission slips issued only between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Callers earlier or later will be denied permission.

Hunters are required to inform the landowner of cancellations at least 2 days in advance of the reserved date(s). Failure to do this may result in the loss of hunting privileges for the remainder of the hunting season on this BMA.

Primary hunting opportunities: Antelope (HD 560), mule deer and whitetail deer (HD 500), and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

Walk-in only, vehicles may be parked along county roads. Vehicles may be allowed on designated roads for game retrieval only with landowner permission. Vehicle travel may be restricted if roads are wet and muddy or in the case of extreme fire danger.

Vehicles will be parked in a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

No camping or open fires allowed, no smoking outside vehicle, leave all gates as you find them.

Access to portions of the ranch may be temporarily restricted due to ranch operations.


Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.

No hunting or shooting around livestock.

These regulations are in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
