

Melville Ranch Block Management Area #62 2016

Hunters, Please be aware of weeds. Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission is required and hunter numbers will be limited to 4 per day or 1 party. Permission can be obtained by calling 665-1091 (beginning August 22). Permission slips will be issued at ranch headquarters (see map). Permission slip must either be on hunting member or displayed on vehicle dash to be seen through windshield.

Primary hunting opportunities: Mule deer, whitetail, and elk (HD 590), antelope (HD 511), turkey, and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

Vehicles permitted only on established roads. Off road travel only to retrieve downed elk. No other off road travel allowed.

Vehicles will be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate. Vehicles may be parked along open roads.

No camping or open fires allowed, no smoking outside vehicle, keep gates closed.

Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant. No hunting allowed where cattle are pastured.


These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.

BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible public lands shown within the BMA boundaries. Abide by managing agency's regulations. Driving is prohibited on State Lands. Walk-in only.
