

Atkins Ranch Block Management Area #66 2016

Hunters, Please be aware of weeds. Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission is required and hunter numbers will be limited to 15 per day. Permission can be obtained in advance by calling the Marshall Wells store in Hardin ((406) 665-2200) from 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday (beginning September 1). Permission slip must be displayed in vehicle windshield or on person hunting.

Primary hunting opportunities: Antelope (HD 511), mule deer and elk (HD 590), turkey, and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

WALK-IN ONLY from designated open roads and parking areas (see map). No vehicles allowed in walk in only area (see map). ATVs and motorcycles are not allowed, except to retrieve downed elk. Walk-in only if roads are wet and muddy.

Vehicles may be parked at the ranch or along open roads. Vehicles will be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

No camping or open fires allowed, no smoking outside vehicle, keep gates closed.

Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant.


These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.

BMA restrictions do not apply to legally accessible public lands shown within the BMA boundaries. Abide by managing agency's regulations. Driving is prohibited on State Lands. Walk-in only.
