

# Lee Ranch Block Management Area #82 2016

**Hunters, Please be aware of weeds.** Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

South Unit: Written permission is required and hunter numbers will be limited to 10 per day. Permission can be obtained by calling 473-2380 (beginning August 22). Permission slips will be issued at ranch headquarters (see map).

North Unit: A written permission slip from the landowner is not required. Permission can be obtained by signing in at the roster box (see map). **Every hunter must fill out a coupon daily before hunting.** Hunter portion of the coupon must be visibly displayed on the vehicle dash. Please return hunter portion of the coupon when done hunting.

Primary hunting opportunities: Mule deer and whitetail deer (HD511, 411, 418), and antelope (HD 501, 420, 430). BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

South Unit: **WALK-IN ONLY.** Vehicles may be parked along county roads and at designated areas. This includes ATVs and motorcycles. Vehicular retrieval of harvested game allowed with landowner permission.

North Unit: Vehicles permitted on established road only. Off road vehicle use is not allowed.

Vehicles will be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

No camping or open fires allowed, no smoking outside vehicle, leave all gates as you find them.


Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant. Limited hunting near livestock.

These regulations shall be in effect from August 15 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
