

VanOosten Ranch Block Management Area #86 2016

Hunters, Please be aware of weeds. Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission is required on the first visit. **On all visits**, hunters will be required to sign in at the registration box (see map) **each day** before hunting. Hunting is limited to 6 people for big game and 1 party of bird hunters per day. Permission slips will be issued at ranch headquarters (see map), and arrangements can be made by calling 326-2112 or 326-2114 (beginning August 22). Telephone calls accepted/permission slips issued only between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. Callers earlier or later will be denied permission. Hunters are required to sign out at the registration box and indicate game animals harvested.

Primary hunting opportunities: Mule deer and elk (HD 570), antelope (HD 570), and upland birds. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

ATVs and motorcycles may only be used for game retrieval, otherwise they are not allowed.

Vehicles permitted only on designated roads (see map). Vehicles allowed on designated roads in walk-in area for game retrieval only. Vehicles may be parked along open roads. Vehicles allowed off roads only to retrieve downed game. This includes ATVs and motorcycles. If wet and muddy or severe fire danger, then **WALK-IN ONLY!** Accommodations may be made for disabled hunters.

Vehicles shall be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

No open fires allowed, no smoking outside vehicle, leave all gates as you find them.


Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant. Livestock are present; be sure of your target and beyond!!

These regulations shall be in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside of this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
