

# White Beaver Ranch Block Management Area #92 2016

**Hunters, Please be aware of weeds.** Noxious weeds threaten your hunting future by destroying critical wildlife habitat and jeopardizing future hunting access. Avoid parking, walking or driving in weeds, **it is suggested that vehicles be washed before and after hunting!**

Written permission from landowner is required. Permission must be obtained in advance of hunting by calling 326-2140 (no earlier than August 22). Telephone calls accepted and permission slips issued 7 a.m. – 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. – 9 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. – 8 p.m. Friday through Sunday. Callers earlier or later will be denied permission. Permission slips and harvest report forms will be issued at ranch headquarters (see map). Hunters are required to inform the landowner of cancellations at least 2 days in advance of the reserved date(s). Failure to do this may result in the loss of hunting privileges for the remainder of the hunting season on this BMA.

Big game hunters will be limited to a maximum of 3 parties or 6 hunters total per day. Bird hunters will be limited to 1 party or 2 hunters per day.

Primary hunting opportunities: Mule deer (HD 570), antelope (HD 570), and turkey. BMA is open to hunting of all legal game species.

**WALK-IN ONLY.** Vehicles may be parked along county road or at ranch headquarters. Off-road vehicle travel is prohibited. ATVs and motorcycles are not allowed.

Vehicles shall be parked in such a manner as to not obstruct traffic or block any gate.

No camping or open fires allowed; no smoking outside vehicle; leave all gates as you find them.

**Please, No Littering – if you pack it in, please pack it out!**

Access to portions of the ranch may be temporarily restricted due to ranch operations.


Firearms shall not be discharged within 1/4 mile of an inhabited building located within the boundaries of the BMA without permission of the inhabitant. No hunting or shooting around livestock.

These regulations are in effect from September 1 through January 1. Access to private lands outside this time period will be at the discretion of the landowner.
