Associated BLM map: Fort Peck West


## BMA RULES

- Motorized vehicles must stay on designated open roads. **IF NO SIGN IS VISIBLE, THAT ROAD IS CLOSED.**
- Off road motorized travel is prohibited
  - **Exception:** Retrieval of **BIG GAME ANIMALS** is allowed using the most direct and least damaging route **on private land only.**
- Private land camping is allowed on camping areas located at Cottonwoods and Timber Creek Camps.
- Open fires are prohibited at designated private camping areas.
- Littering is prohibited on all lands.
- All gates must be left as found, unless signed OPEN or CLOSED.
- **Map depicts actual ranch pasture boundaries. BMA applies only to private lands within these pasture boundaries.**

**Separate restrictions apply to public lands within or adjoining the boundaries of the BMA. Please, contact your local federal and state agencies for more information.**
