2016 General Harvest Rules

Walk-in, Drag-out Hunt (either sex) (C West, C North, Area E)

Schedule Rules:

1. Hunting is allowed with **written permission only**. The permission slip provided by WECO security must be signed and kept in your possession while hunting.
2. All hunters must come to the Security Office to **physically sign in and physically sign out** of all hunting areas.
3. You **must** notify WECO security by **noon** of your scheduled date if you are unable to hunt.
4. Harvest dates will be reserved on a first come/first served basis. Harvesters will be allotted the entire day.
5. Harvest dates must be reserved two days in advance. You may call (406) 748-5156 or stop at WECO Security at any time to reserve a spot. Reservations will **NOT** be confirmed by voicemail.
6. Once you have been scheduled, you may not reserve a new hunt until 72 hours after your scheduled day.
7. If you violate any "schedule rules", your hunting privileges will be suspended for the remainder of the season **AND** the following season.

Hunt Rules:


1. General Area (Rifles allowed). Only rifles larger than .22 calibers will be allowed
2. Each hunter is limited to one party per day. Parties will consist of a maximum of two (2) hunters. Immediate non-hunting family members (i.e. son, daughter, mother, father or spouse) may accompany the hunters.
3. Persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
4. Wounded animals that cross property boundaries cannot be trailed without the permission of the landowner. It is the hunter's responsibility to obtain the appropriate permission. Any violation (trespassing) may result in forfeiture of hunting privileges and/or landowner action.
5. If you violate any of the "Hunt Rules" your hunting privileges will be suspended indefinitely (at least two hunting seasons).

General Information:

1. A map designating property boundaries and hunting areas is provided. Permit boundary signs delineate the area in the field and are indicated on field maps. Trespassing is not allowed (see above).
2. Vehicles are required to park at designated parking areas (see maps).
3. Do not drive off the road! This is very important.
4. Information on ethics, safety, and marksmanship will be read before each hunt.
5. All Montana game laws and regulations must be followed.
6. Extreme control on site and shot selection is necessary for safety.
7. This hunting privilege is for the designated site and does not gain access to any Montana State Lands section.
8. Please report all harvest details for record keeping purposes.
9. Report all encountered problems to WECO security. They will contact the appropriate authority for needed action.
