Application for permit to possess captive-reared upland game birds for non-commercial purposes

Note: Applicants wishing to possess upland game birds for non-commercial purposes must complete this application and submit it to the regional office where the upland game birds will be held. A possession permit does not allow the holder to sell upland game birds or any parts of upland game birds nor does it allow for the release of any upland game birds. Birds must be held at all times in enclosures adequate to keep wild upland game birds out and captive reared upland game birds in. **All applicants must sign the application in the space provided below. Permit expires on December 31 of the year of issue.**
