Forms of acceptable proof to receive a Nonresident Montana Native Hunting License

A copy of your current Driver's license or state issued photo ID must be submitted along with the following documentation.

Check the box next to the documentation you have supplied in each requirement category, only one box needs to be checked per category to apply. Attach a copy of the documentation you selected to this application. If unable to provide documentation the licenses cannot be issued. Affidavits will not qualify as proof or evidence.

1. Birth certificate verifying the applicants birth in Montana or documentation that the applicant was born to parents who were residents at the time of birth.
 - Applicant's birth certificate proving birth in Montana.
 - Applicant's birth certificate proving birth in another state/country listing the parents address as Montana.
 - Applicant's birth certificate and documentation that the parents were residents at time of birth. (The applicant must provide the proof that their parents were MT residents at the time of Birth in the form of Tax records, Parents DD 214 showing military service at time of birth with home of record as MT.)
 - Applicant's birth certificate and copy of adoption papers, showing parents as MT residents at the time of adoption.

2. Evidence that the applicant previously held a Montana resident hunting or fishing license or passed a hunters safety course in Montana.
 - Copy of MT resident hunting or fishing license.
 - Copy of MT resident hunter education certificate. Copies available online at: <http://fwp.mt.gov/education/hunter/born.html>
 - Email from MT FWP verifying the applicant held MT hunting or fishing license. (emails requesting this information can be sent to fwplic@mt.gov, provide your name, DOB and year you purchased a license.) Note : requests from 1976 to 1989 are on microfiche and will take up to four weeks to respond.

3. Proof that the applicant is a relative of a Montana resident who meets the qualifications of a resident. (Natural or adoptive, child, parent, or sibling)
 - For Montana relative who is the applicant's parent and the parent is listed on the applicant's birth certificate, provide a copy of parent's MT driver's license or MT photo ID.
 - For Montana relative who is the applicant's sibling, provide birth certificate of sibling showing the same parents and a copy of the sibling's MT driver's license or MT photo ID.
 - For Montana relative who is the applicant's child, provide birth certificate of the child showing the applicant as a parent and a copy of the child's MT driver's license or MT photo ID.
 - For adopted relative, a copy of adoption papers and a copy of the relative's MT drivers license or MT photo ID.
