Coming Home to Hunt

During the 2009 Montana Legislative Session, a bill was passed promoting Montana's family hunting heritage by creating nonresident combination hunting licenses for use by adult nonresident family members who wish to return to Montana to hunt with a family member. Under this law, up to 500 Nonresident Big Game Combination and 500 Nonresident Deer Combination licenses can be issued. All money received from the sale of these licenses, must be used by the department to acquire public hunting access to inaccessible public land. **NOTE: Do you qualify for Nonresident Native License? See our web site or call for more information.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMING HOME TO HUNT

Part A: Mandatory To Be Completed By The Applicant

- * All information in Part A must be filled in and completed by the Applicant.
 - * Applications must be on a current year, department approved form. Photocopied applications with original signatures are acceptable.
 - * The nonresident applicant must have completed a Montana hunter safety and education course prior to March 1, 2010 or have previously purchased a Montana resident hunting license.
 - * The nonresident applicant must be sponsored by a family member (second degree Kinship) who must be a resident as defined in 87-2-102, who is 18 years old or older and possesses a current Montana resident hunting license.
 - * Applicants who are unsuccessful in the drawing will be entered in the general drawing for a nonresident license provided under 87-2-505 or 87-2-510, as applicable.
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Part B: Mandatory To Be Completed By The Adult Sponsor

- * All information in Part B must be filled in and completed by the Sponsor.
 - * The sponsor must be a family member who is a resident as defined in 87-2-102, who is 18 years old or older, **possesses a current resident hunting license**, and who is related to the nonresident applicant within the second degree of kinship by blood or marriage.
 - * **The second degree of kinship includes a mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, spouse, grandparent, grandchild, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, father-in-law, mother-in law, stepfather, stepmother, stepbrother, stepsister, stepson, and stepdaughter.**
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Part C: Applicant must choose ONE.

- * **Applicant may only apply for one combination package.**
 - * Preference point system: Applicants may choose to participate in the Preference Point system if applying for one of the Combination Licenses. Please check the appropriate box and if you wish to participate, include the \$50.00 nonrefundable fee along with your license fee. If you submit an application with or without a preference point on your application, you are not eligible to purchase one during the July 1 - September 30, 2013 time period.
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Part D: List The Family Members Who Will Hunt With The Nonresident Applicant

- * **A nonresident applicant who receives a license must be accompanied in the field by a family member(s) who must be a resident as defined in 87-2-102, who is 18 years old or older, possesses a current Montana resident hunting license, and who is related to the nonresident within the second degree of kinship as described above.**

THE SECOND DEGREE OF KINSHIP INCLUDES: mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, spouse, grandparent, grandchild, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, father-in-law, mother-in law stepfather, stepmother, stepbrother, stepsister, stepson, and stepdaughter.
