Don't miss this hands-on firearms class that instills comfort and confidence in your shooting. This 1-day class designed for women will provide a basic understanding of how to safely handle and shoot a variety of firearms including shotguns, rifles and handguns. The class concludes with a session on gun cleaning. This is a great opportunity for the new or novice shooter to practice and/or enhance her skills and to become more comfortable with all types of firearms in a non-threatening and fun-oriented environment.

The class is taught by Becoming an Outdoors-Woman instructors and Fergus County Hunter Ed Instructors. Class size is limited.
