ALS - Automated Licensing System

- Montana hunting, fishing and other recreational licenses are issued via an automated licensing system (ALS).
- Once you acquire a license through ALS, you will be assigned a lifetime "ALS number". The ALS number is your birth date plus a random number issued by the automated system. Your ALS number will print at the top of your license.
- If you do not have an ALS number, you MUST provide your date-of-birth and the last 4 digits of your social security number.
- Montana's license year is March 1 through the end of February of the following year. Even though you may have a lifetime ALS number, EACH YEAR a person must purchase a conservation license to be authorized to purchase any fishing or hunting licenses.

Attention Bowhunters

- To purchase a Bow & Arrow license, all bowhunters must provide a copy of a National Bowhunter Education Foundation (NBEF) certificate OR provide any prior year bowhunting/archery stamp, tag, permit or license from any state or province.
- All bowhunters born after January 1, 1985 must show proof of also completing a Hunter Education program before purchasing any hunting license.
- A bow and arrow license, plus the proper hunting license is required during an Archery Only Season or an Arch-Equip only area or hunting district.

Hunter Education Requirement

- Legislation requires anyone born after January 1, 1985 to provide a copy of his or her Hunter Education Certificate in order to purchase any hunting license in Montana.

Turkey License

Turkey hunters may harvest up to 9 wild turkeys in Montana using a combination of the following turkey license options:

- A General Hunting Area License may be purchased Over-the-Counter or online, limit one per hunter. The license is valid to harvest one wild turkey in a General Hunting Area, either one male wild turkey in the spring or one either-sex wild turkey in the fall.
- Regional Turkey Licenses are available Over-the-Counter or online. A hunter may purchase up to 6 Regional Turkey Licenses per year: one each in Regional Turkey Areas R1, R2, R5 and R7, and one additional Female or Beardless Turkey-only License in each of Regional Turkey Areas R1 and R2. Licenses for Regional Turkey Areas R1, R2 and R7 are valid for one male wild turkey in the spring or one either-sex wild turkey in the fall. The R5 Regional Turkey License is only valid in the spring for one male wild turkey. The additional Female or Beardless Turkey-only Licenses for Regional Turkey Areas R1 and R2 are only valid during the fall season.
- Special Drawing Turkey Licenses are available by special drawing only. Spring licenses are offered in parts of R2, R3 and R4. The application deadline for a spring Special Drawing Turkey License is March 3. Fall licenses are offered in parts of R2 and R3. The application deadline for a fall license is July 28.

Options for the cost of a Turkey License:

- If a hunter holds a conservation, base hunting and upland game bird license the cost for each turkey license is \$57.50 per license.
- If a hunter holds only a conservation and base hunting license the cost for each turkey license is \$115 per license.

3-Day Upland Game Bird

3-day nonresident upland game bird license for \$50, valid for three consecutive calendar days (Which are indicated on the license). The license is not valid for sage grouse at any time or for ring-neck pheasants during the opening week of the season.

Black Bear

- You may hold only one black bear license per year but the license may be used in either Spring or Fall.
- Hunters must take and pass a bear identification test before purchasing a 2016 black bear hunting license. There are two ways to take the test and receive your certification:
 - ONLINE at FWP's website at fwp.mt.gov and click on Education, then Hunter Education, choose Bear Identification Program OR
 - MAIL IN - Request a mail-in test by calling 406-444-2535.
- License providers will not process the test or return them to FWP.
- If you previously passed the Bear ID test AND purchased a black bear license in Montana, you do not need to submit a bear certificate.

License Purchase Restrictions:

- A Spring black bear license purchased after April 14 is available at any FWP license provider, FWP office or through our Online Licensing at fwp.mt.gov AND may not be used until 24 hours after the license is issued.
- A black bear license purchased after August 31 is available at an FWP license provider, FWP office or through our Online Licensing at fwp.mt.gov AND may not be used until 24 hours after the license is issued.

State Lands

The State Land Recreational Use License is included as part of the Conservation License. Therefore, persons who are licensed to hunt, fish, or trap are not required to obtain a recreational use license for use of legally accessible state trust land for hunting, fishing, and trapping purposes.

Mailing Lists

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks receives requests for mailing lists. Note that even if you chose no, under state law the department is required to allow individuals who wish to compile their own mailing list access to department records including your name, address, gender, residency status, license type, district applied for and whether you were successful in the drawing.
