


KAYAK CAMPING ADVENTURE

August 5-7, 2016 ~ CLARK FORK RIVER



INTERMEDIATE PADDLE ~ From St. Regis to Paradise (approximately 30 miles)

SCHEDULE:

FRIDAY, 8/5: Meet at the Peninsula Campground (after 4:00p.m.) for dinner and "opening ceremonies" which will include a detailed outline of the weekend's schedule and activities.

SATURDAY, 8/6: In the morning, we will carpool to the put-in at St. Regis. Our paddle will be from St. Regis back to the Peninsula Campground (15 miles) for a delicious Dutch oven dinner around the campfire. After dinner we will drive our cars to the take out in Paradise and scout out the rapid on our day 2 float.

SUNDAY, 8/7: After a hearty breakfast, we will break down camp and hit the water for another fun filled day of paddling (approximately 15 miles), swimming, fishing, picture taking, etc.

 Participants will need to provide their own kayaks, paddles, life jackets and camping gear. Six meals will be provided: dinner on Friday & Saturday; breakfast on Saturday and Sunday and; a "box" lunch for our Saturday and Sunday paddle. If needed, kayaks can be rented from the following businesses: Thompson Falls: Crazy Woman Kayaks, (406)827-0052; Missoula: The Trailhead, (406)543-6966; Kalispell: Rock Mountain Outfitter, (406)752-5446.

*****This section of the river contains several "riffles" and a small rapid which we will scout before setting out. Know your skill level. It is possible you could become a valued member of the "swim team."*****
