ALS - Automated Licensing System

- Montana hunting, fishing and other recreational licenses are issued via an automated licensing system (ALS).
- Once you acquire a license through ALS, you will be assigned a lifetime “ALS number”. The ALS number is your birth date plus a random number issued by the automated system. Your ALS number will print at the top of your license.
- If you do not have an ALS number, you MUST provide your date-of-birth and the last 4 digits of your social security number.
- Montana’s license year is March 1 through the end of February of the following year. Even though you may have a lifetime ALS number, EACH YEAR a person must purchase a conservation license to be authorized to purchase any fishing or hunting licenses.

Hunter/Trapper Education Requirements

Hunter Education for Firearm and Archery

- If you were born after January 1, 1985, you are required to showproof of completing a Montana hunter safety and education course (or an approved hunter safety course from any other state or province) prior to applying for or purchasing a hunting license, whether the hunting license is for the rifle or archery season.
- Montana law requires members of the armed forces and their dependents stationed in Montana to present a Montana hunter education certificate or similar certificate from any state or province when purchasing any Montana hunting license.
- Duplicates – Montana certificates of completion for the Montana hunter education and/or bowhunter education courses may be obtained from FWP’s website.

Wolf Trapper Certification – A person must attend and complete a wolf trapping certification class before setting any trap for a wolf.

Completion of either the Idaho or Montana wolf trapping certification class will be recognized as meeting this requirement.

Bowhunter Education Requirements

To purchase a Montana bow and arrow license, a hunter must:

- Provide a certificate of completing the National Bowhunter Education Foundation course (NBEF), OR provide any prior year’s bowhunting/archery stamp, tag, permit, or license from any state or province.
- A bow and arrow license, plus the proper hunting license is required during an Archery Only Season or an Arch-Equip only area or hunting district.

State Lands

The State Land Recreational Use License is included as part of the Conservation License. Therefore, persons who are licensed to hunt, fish, or trap are not required to obtain a recreational use license for use of legally accessible state trust land for hunting, fishing, and trapping purposes.

What’s New & Reminders

- Avoid harvesting wolves with radio collars. Collared wolves provide researchers with important information.
- A wolf harvest must be reported within 24 hours.
- Any Wolf Management Unit (WMU) can close upon a 24-hour notice.
- A wolf license must be purchased by February 28, 2017.
- Apprentice Hunters - visit <http://fwp.mt.gov> for details.

Hunting

- After August 31, a wolf hunting license becomes valid 24 hours after purchase.
- Electronic calls can be used for wolf hunting.

Trapping

- WMU 313 is closed to wolf trapping in the Deckard Flats to Trail Creek Wolf Trapping Closure Area.
- Wolf trap pan tension must be at least 10 pounds in Regions 1,2,3,4 and 5.
- Trappers must immediately dispatch a trapped wolf by gunshot – unless otherwise authorized not to do so by FWP prior to wolf trapping efforts.
- A 150-foot setback is required for wolf traps along open roads and hiking trails on public federal and state lands.
