1. Copy of your drivers license.
2. Provide a copy of your birth certificate verifying your birth in Montana, OR Documentation that you were born to parents who were residents of Montana at the time of your birth.
3. Proof of possessing a previous Montana resident hunting or fishing license, OR proof of passage of a Montana hunter education course.
4. Proof that you are a nonresident relative of a living Montana resident who is your natural or adoptive parent, sibling, or child.

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Forms of acceptable proof to receive a Nonresident Montana Native Hunting License

Check the box next to the documentation you have supplied in each required category. Only one box needs to be checked per category. Attach a copy of the documentation you selected to this application. If unable to provide documentation, the licenses cannot be issued. Affidavits or last years Native license will not qualify as proof or evidence. You must submit documentation every year to receive Native License.

1. A copy of your current Driver's license or state issued photo ID must be submitted.
2. Copy of Birth certificate verifying the applicants birth in Montana OR documentation that the applicant was born to parents who were residents of Montana at the time of birth.
 - Copy of applicant's birth certificate proving birth in Montana.
 - Copy of applicant's birth certificate proving birth in another state/country, birth certificate must show parents were residents of Montana at the time of birth.
 - Copy of applicant's birth certificate and documentation that the parents were residents of Montana at time of birth. (The applicant must provide the proof that their parents were residents of Montana at the time of Birth in the form of Tax records, Parents DD-214 showing military service at time of birth with home of record as Montana.)
 - Copy of applicant's birth certificate and copy of adoption papers, showing parents as Montana residents at the time of adoption.
3. Evidence that the applicant previously held a Montana resident hunting or fishing license OR passed a hunters safety course in Montana.
 - Copy of a Montana hunter education certificate. Copies available online at:

 - Copy of a Montana resident hunting or fishing license.
 - E-mail from Montana FWP verifying the applicant held a resident Montana hunting or fishing license. (E-mail requesting this information can be sent to fwplic@mt.gov, provide your name, DOB and year you purchased a license.) Note: requests from 1976 to 1989 are on microfiche and will take up to four weeks to respond.
4. Proof that the applicant is a relative of a living Montana resident who meets the qualifications of a resident. (Natural or adoptive, child, parent, or sibling)
 - For Montana relative who is the applicant's parent and the parent is listed on the applicant's birth certificate, provide a copy of parent's current/valid Montana driver's license or Montana photo ID.
 - For Montana relative who is the applicant's sibling, provide birth certificate of sibling showing the same parents AND a copy of the sibling's current/valid Montana driver's license or Montana photo ID.
 - For Montana relative who is the applicant's child, provide birth certificate of the child showing the applicant as a parent AND a copy of the child's current/valid Montana driver's license or Montana photo ID.
 - For adopted relative, a copy of adoption papers AND a copy of the relative's current/valid Montana driver's license or Montana photo ID.
