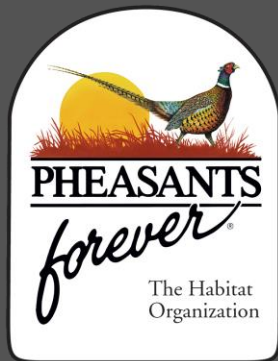


Pheasants Forever Partner Biologists

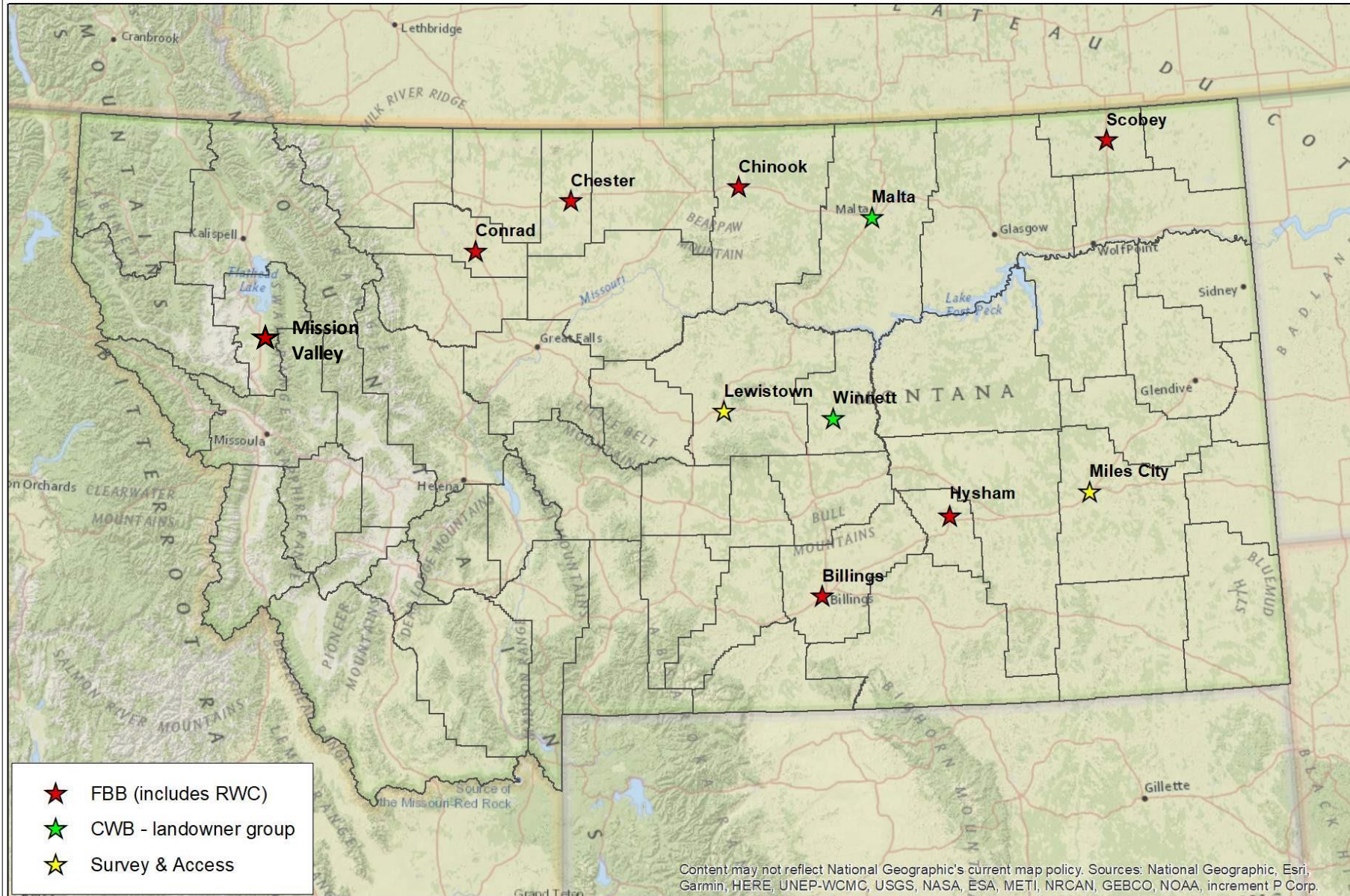
