Building on efforts from a 2021 intern, this position will expand social media presence for river recreation in the greater Missoula area, concentrating on recreate responsibly messaging and coordinating message with other partners such as Missoula County, Clark Fork Coalition, Three Rivers Collaborative, Missoula Downtown Partnership, Destination Missoula and Missoula River Ambassadors. This position will also take part in on site management with a focus on river users to Milltown State Park and Sha-Ron FAS. This is a dynamic position with an opportunity to work with a variety of agency and NGO partners on unique management approaches that now include public transportation to access sites; a holistic approach to enforcement; the use of social media to inform and engage the public; and a community commitment to collaborative solutions to access and conservation.
