The Recreational Trails Program has selected 36 projects to receive funding for the 2024 Grant Cycle, for a total of \$ \$1,519,659.98. This document contains a summary list of all selected projects. Pursuant to § 23-2-657(1)(b), MCA, the process for awarding a grant is subject to environmental review according to the applicable requirements of the Montana Environmental Protection Act (MEPA). Each of the recommended RTP projects included supplemental environmental review documents within its application to aid in the review process. Projects were categorized to have either Routine Resource Impacts (e.g., clearing of an existing trail corridor) or Unique Resource Impacts (e.g., construction of new trailhead facilities). projects that were categorized as Unique Resource Impacts were reviewed using an extensive checklist review form which was then transferred to a standardized environmental analysis form for the purposes of the public comment period.
