# Madison River Rulemaking Public Comment Summary (September 28-October 30)

781 individuals provided comments, either in writing, through the internet, or at the public hearing. Multiple comments from individuals were combined and counted as a single entry here. One petition was received with 312 signers, stating their opposition to New Rule I (commercial cap at 2019 levels) and New Rule II (rest rotation). Consistent with other Fisheries efforts to summarize public comments, the opinions of the petition were recorded as a single entry for the purposes of this summary. Percentages below are calculated as the number of people supporting/opposing a particular issue relative to the total number of commenters (781).
