The Restrictions and Closures Rule that implements the hoot owl restrictions is currently being revised. With the new revisions it is anticipated that there will no longer be a need for a standing hoot owl on the Lower Madison. The Department will propose to lift the standing hoot owl and to manage using the drought rule.
