Commissioner Lane:

I suspect Brett will have a more detailed answer to your question so will let him respond.

My thoughts in simple terms:

• Last spring we asked you to reduce the bull elk quota in 700 as we have seen a marked decline in bull numbers and in the bull:cow ratio over the past two surveys. We are far below the 30-40 bulls:100 cows listed as the elk plan goal. This trend is of great concern to us and thus we asked for a reduction until our surveys show these numbers increase to the 30-40 bull/100 cow goal. We haven't seen an increase in bull numbers since spring.

Brett has more data and information, but I think you have the latest information that we provided this spring when we were out to your place.

Brett has his own opinions, but in my mind we should not be increasing the bull licenses in 700 until we see bull numbers increase to what is listed in the elk plan goals.



Hunters perceive money spent on a tag should result in a dead animal. The more money spent increases the need for results. This is a fact. I would propose to change the culture with the new e-tag system. Understandably the state needs to continue making the same dollar amount.

Consider separating the hunting license. One would be a hunting permit and the second would be a harvest permit. One might consider it the old trophy fee. I would consider it a harvest fee. This would be an opportunity to capitalize on our resource and put it more in the catch and release category. Potentially an additional \$250 harvest fee would limit killing immature bucks on the last day of the hunt. In state hunters are more often allowing the immature animals to live. As you know, a suit was brought against FWP and the FW Commission regarding the Special Meeting that was held on September 25, 2023. One of the demands is for all "correspondence" regarding ARM 12.9.1303 (Gray Wolf ARM) between employees of FWP and the Fish and Wildlife Commission from October 27, 2022 to present. This only applies

to correspondence involving ARM 12.9.1303 (Gray Wolf ARM) and nothing more. For clarity, "correspondence" is legally defined in this request as:

any written communication between, or among, individuals or entities. It includes memos, letters, emails, text messages, online posts, or written entries made on a webpage, portal, website, or in software. It also includes any logs of unwritten communications between, or among, individuals or entities.

This interrogatory requires that any and all such "correspondence", as it pertains to the listed ARM, be produced and provided to the requester. In this case, the deadline for our answer, including all of the requested correspondence, is November 17th. This is going to require you to go back through all of those methods listed in the definition and provide them to FWP Legal to assist in formulating the department's answer. You can send them all to me for ease of destination and I can forward them to Legal, if you wish. Again, this only applies to correspondence involving ARM 12.9.1303 (Gray Wolf ARM)
